- The application must be completed and received by this lodge not later than 1 April 2025. Applications must be authenticated and forwarded to this lodge by the applicant's school of record.
- Scholastic achievement, needs based, extracurricular activities and submissions are weighed by the lodge in determining recipients.
- The scholarship may be awarded for collegiate or technical programs.
- Awardees must be accepted by the higher institutions and proof of enrollment submitted to the lodge. After which the funds will be released to that school in the student's name. There are no exceptions to this policy.
- Scholarships awards will be announced 1 May 2025. The high school of record will be notified of the selections made.
